All day

All day

Hope Town

Grizzli Winery

Grizzli Winery is located in the center of Okanagan, Canada. The Grizzli Winery is surrounded by a number of mountains and lakes! Itinerary:

Revelstoke / Salmon Arm → Glacier National Park (Pass-by) → Yoho National Park (Pass-by) → Banff National Park → Lake Louise (120 mins, including lunch time and sightseeing time) → Moraine Lake (15 mins) → Banff Gondola (60 mins) → Bow Falls (15 mins) → Banff Town (60 mins)

Special Note:

1. The opening time of Moraine Lake is from mid-June to mid-October. If it is not open during the tour, the scenic spot will be cancelled, and the tour time of Louise Lake will be increased accordingly.

All day

Glacier National Park

Night

Hotel: Irwin's Mountain Inn Or Red Carpet Inn Or similar

Day 3

Icefield Avenue - Vehicle - Columbia Icefield - Vehicle - Jasper

All day

Depart from the Banff Hotel in the morning, overlooking the Crow's Claw Glacier along the way. The first thing you will visit is Bow Lake, where the silhouette of the Rocky Mountains is clearly reflected on the lake. You can visit the lakeside Num-Ti-Jah Inn and learn the story of legendary Rocky Mountain guide Jimmy Thompson. Then came to Peyto Lake, the maple-leaf-shaped lake is like a blue ribbon inlaid in the Rocky Mountain valley. Then drive on the beautiful No. 93 Icefield Avenue to Columbia Glacier. Take an ice snowmobile and walk on the Athabasca Glacier to experience the beauty of nature accumulated over hundreds of millions of years; you can also step on the 280-meter-high Skywalk to have a panoramic view of the Sunwapta Valley. Then go to Athabasca Falls, which was formed by the erosion of ice and snow, with a drop of 23 meters. Finally, drive to the hotel in Jasper town for check-in.

Itinerary:

Banff → **Crow's Claw Glacier** (pass by, overlooking) → **Bow Lake** (30 mins) → **Peyto Lake** (20 mins) → **Icefields Avenue** (pass by) → **Icefield Center Lunch** (optional, 60 mins) → **Icefield Snowmobile & Skywalk** (150 mins) → **Athabasca Falls** (30 mins) → **Jasper**

Special Note:

1. In case Peyto Lake is closed due to force majeure factors such as maintenance and weather, the itinerary will go to Waterflow Lake.

Morning

Bow Lake

Bow Lake is located approximately 30 minutes north of Lake Louise and off the Icefields Parkway (Hwy 93) in the Canadian Rockies. It is half a mile north of the Crowfoot Glacier. It sits at an elevation of 1,920 m (6,300 ft) and is one of the largest lakes at the Banff National Park. It is fed by the meltwater from the Bow Glacier in the Wapta Icefield. Bow Lake is a wonderful place for a picnic and to enjoy scenic breathtaking views.

Peyto Lake

Peyto Lake is a popular sightseeing spot! It is a glacier-fed lake in Banff National Park in the Canadian Rockies. The lake itself is near the Icefields Parkway. During the summer, a significant amount of glacial rock flour flows into the lake from a nearby glacier. The suspended rock particles are what give the lake a unique bright, turquoise color. Due to its bright color, photos of the lake often appear in illustrated books.

Afternoon

Columbia Icefield

Columbia Icefield is what is left of a gigantic sheet of ice that covered and formed most of the landscape in the Rocky Mountains. The Ice field covers an area today of 325 square kilometers or 130 square miles and is such an amazing location to explore!

Athabasca Falls

Night

Hotel: Lobstick Lodge Or Marmot Lodge Jasper Or Athabasca Hotel Or similar

All day

Depart from the hotel, pass through Wuyao Lake, and arrive at Maligne Lake, the second largest glacial lake in the world. Take a cruise on Maligne Lake to swim on the lake, and slowly approach the "place where God meets" - Elf Island. Then head to the longest and deepest Maligne Canyon in the Rocky Mountains. The canyon was formed by the erosion of glaciers, and the deep rocks are fascinating.

Itinerary:

Jasper → Maligne Lake (you can take a cruise at your own expense, 90 mins) → **Elf Island → Maligne Canyon** (30 mins) → **Lunch** (at your own expense, you can add a buffet at the Maligne Canyon Wilderness Restaurant, 60 mins) → **Banff**

Special Note:

1. If the Maligne Lake Cruise is not open due to seasonal or weather reasons, the itinerary will be replaced by Pyramid Lake and Patricia Lake

Morning

Jasper National Park

Jasper National Park spans 4,200 square miles (10,878 square km) and contains significant active geologic processes, scenic mountains, along with diverse animal and plant populations. When Jasper was first protected as a forest park in 1907, it covered an area of approximately 5,000 square miles (12,950 square km). In 1930 it was declared a national park with its present size. It was designated part of UNESCO's Canadian Rocky Mountain Parks World Heritage site in 1984.

Maligne Lake

Maligne Lake is the largest natural lake in the Canadian Rockies. Ringed by snow-and-ice-capped mountains, the 22 km long lake stretches past serene Spirit Island right to the melt-water channels of Coronet Glacier. An open forest of lodgepole pine and spruce, home of moose, Harlequin Ducks, and many other types of wildlife surround visitors at the north end of the lake.

Maligne Canyon

Maligne Canyon is the deepest canyon in Jasper National Park, with a depth of more than 50 metres at certain points.

Night

Hotel: Banff Caribou Lodge Or Banff Ptarmigan Inn Or Canalta Lodge Or The Rundlestone Lodge Or similar

Day 5

Banff free time - Vehicle - Calgary

All day

Today, you will start the free travel mode of Banff town, you can roam the town freely, walk into any boutique, you can find local souvenirs or delicious snacks, or participate in our carefully prepared various Activities at their own expense.

Optional activities do not include transportation and tour guide services, and guests are responsible for their own transportation expenses.

Optional activities recommended:

- Stroll through the Cave and Basin National Historic Site (at your own expense), learn about the history of the birth of Banff National Park, and explore the process of changing historical sites. 13,000 years of history and humanistic complex have been deposited here, so you might as well calm down and feel its inner vigorous power.
- Enjoy a British-style afternoon tea (BSH afternoon Tea) in the world cultural heritage Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel (Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel), with the Bow Valley as the background, enjoying the food and scenery. (Experience time: about 1.5 hours)
- Don't take the usual way, check in Lake Minnewanka (Lake Minnewanka), the filming location of the Hollywood blockbuster "The Revenant", and take a Lake Minnewanka cruise to find the beautiful scenery in the promotional film of the Tourism Bureau; take #6 from the town of Banff Bus No. 1 goes to the boarding point for free. (Experience time: about 2-2.5 hours, of which about 1 hour by boat)
- Participate in the Hoodoos Boat Tour on the Bow River, and the scenery is like a movie. (Activity time: about 1 hour)
- Take a retro sightseeing car, start the legendary tour of Banff, and use a special form to start a journey with a sense of the times. (Activity time: about 1 hour)
- Follow the guide to participate in the Banff day trip (BL01): Banff Cable Car (at your own expense) → Joneston Canyon → Bow River Falls → Surprise Corner (activity time: about 7 hours)
